

## PUBLIC NOTICE TOWN OF WELLS VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place at the SPRING ELECTION may request to vote with an absentee ballot. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen, who will be 18 years of age or older on the SPRING ELECTION to be held on Tuesday, April 7th, 2026 who has resided in the ward or municipality where he or she wishes to vote for at least 28 consecutive days before the election. The elector must also be registered in order to receive an absentee ballot. Proof of identification must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued.

TO OBTAIN AN ABSENTEE BALLOT YOU MUST MAKE A REQUEST IN WRITING OR ONLINE AT [MyVote.wi.gov](https://MyVote.wi.gov). Contact your municipal clerk and request that an application for an absentee ballot be sent to you for the primary or election or both. You may also request an absentee ballot by letter. Your written request must list your voting address within the municipality where you wish to vote, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different, and your signature. You may make application to your municipal clerk for an absentee ballot in person, by mail, by email or at [MyVote.wi.gov](https://MyVote.wi.gov). Special absentee voting application provisions apply to electors who are indefinitely confined to home or a care facility, in the military, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact the municipal clerk. You can also personally go to the clerk's office or other specified location, complete a written application, and vote an absentee ballot during the hours specified for casting an absentee ballot.

To obtain an absentee ballot, send a written request to: DIANE SCHWARZ 24324 STATE HIGHWAY 27, CASHTON, WI 54619 608-654-8435 The deadline for making an application to vote absentee by mail is 5:00 p.m. on the fourth day before the election (Friday, April 3rd, 2026) (Military electors should contact the municipal clerk regarding the deadlines for requesting or submitting an absentee ballot.) The first day to vote with an absentee ballot in the clerk's office is Tuesday, March 24th, 2026). The deadline for voting an absentee ballot in the clerk's office is 5:00 p.m. on the Sunday before the election (April 4th, 2026). All voted ballots must be returned to the municipal clerk, so the clerk can deliver them to the proper polling place before the polls close on the SPRING ELECTION April 7th, 2026. Any ballots received after the polls close will not be counted.
