WHAT TO RECYCLE

HOW TO PREPARE

NEWSPAPERS - MAGAZINES - OTHER PAPERS

NEWS PRINT, MAGAZINES, SLICK ADVERTISERS, ENVELOPES AND SIMILAR PAPER INCLUDING PHONE BOOKS, PAPERBACK BOOKS, COMIC BOOKS AND CATALOGS.

SHOULD BE LOOSE IN A BROWN PAPER SACK, SMALL CARDBOARD BOX, PLASTIC GROCERY TYPE BAG OR REUSABLE CONTAINER THAT CAN BE DUMPED AT POINT OF COLLECTION.

CARDBOARD, PAPER SACKS AND FOOD BOXES WITHOUT A WAX OR PLASTIC COATING

SHOULD BE FLATTENED AND PUT IN A PAPER BAG OR A CARDBOARD BOX.
DO NOT INCLUDE ANY SODA OR BEER CARTONS!

GLASS CONTAINERS

Jars & Bottles ONLY!

Rinse Clean

No need to remove labels

Remove lids and caps,
recycle metal lids or caps
with tin or aluminum.

DO NOT INCLUDE ANY LIGHT BULBS
GLASSES, WINDOW GLASS OR MIRRORS..

TIN CANS (STEEL)

Food cans, empty paint & aerosol cans
Paint cans must be empty and dry
Empty aerosol cans through normal use
Magnets Will Attract Steel

Rinse clean

No Need to Remove Labels

To Save Space, Flatten if possible

ALUMINUM

Cans, Trays, Pans, Foil & caps

Rinse and stack trays together

Magnets Will NOT Attract Aluminum

PLASTIC

Bottles & Containers Marked 1 or 2 on bottom:

soda, food and liquor bottles
and other clear plastic bottles.

Remove caps and discard

Rinse Clean

Flatten if possible

milk, juice, soap, shampoo, etc.

Remove metal handles or caps

DO NOT INCLUDE ANY OIL OR ANTIFREEZE BOTTLES!
